HOME NEWS

120801 - The "January I" Reservoir is the symbol of heroism of the Kampuchea's people in building up the country.

The Chinit river has a permanent source of water both in dry and rainy seasons. This river goes through the Kampong Thom region, Central Zone, before flowing into the Tonle Sap.

During the five years period of war against US imperialism, the movement of transports had been always carried out by this river in spite of the feverish activities of spying and repression of the enemy planes.

In the present period of national defence and construction, the Chinit river has become more and more important. This river has provided the people with consumption water, fishes and transport lines of other materials in every season. More particularly, this Chinit river has been transformed into an important reservoir serving the agricultural production in this region. Many ten thousands persons from the peasant cooperatives, youth mobile brigades and Revolutionary Army in the Central Zone have united together into an impetuous mass move-

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ment, overcome all obstacles with a constant revolutionary optimism and dammed this river during only five months, from January to May 1977. The reservoir can irrigate 20,000 ha of rice-fields. The water level of this reservoir is high of many meters in dry season. In rainy season, the high level of water makes the aspect of this reservoir like the Tonle Sap lake. The cooperative peasants have digged two canals of many tens of kilometers length from this reservoir, one to the district of Santuk and another to the district of Baray. Therefore, at present, the Chinit river flows at a definite regime fixed by the people of the Central Zone.

This victory is a historic and unprecedented event. That is why, the cooperative peasants and youth mobile brigades, masters of this reservoir, say with joy, emotion and self-confidence in their forces that "under the wise leadership of the Communist Party of Kampuchea, the Kampuchea's collectivist people are able to do everything."

Down the reservoir, especially on the two sides of the two canals, the rainy season rice-fields show a flourishing aspect. This year, the paddy is growing well and will give a much better harvest than all previous years.

At present, thanks to the "January 1" reservoir, the cooperative peasants and youth mobile brigades continue to hold aloft the banner of further impetuously growing late season rice and dry season rice in order to get more paddy crops for improving their standard of living and most quickly promote the building up of advanced cooperatives in the Central Zone and throughout the country.

120802 - Soya-bean culture in Democratic Kampuchea

Soya-bean constitutes an important secondary culture among all kinds of beans and other various secondary cultures.

Being aware of the importance of soya-bean and as it is easy to cultivate, the Kampuchea's people throughout the country have paid great attention to grow soya-bean in many regions. Large soya-bean fields are located along the rivers and on table land regions like in Sa Ang, Koh Thom region (South-West Zone) and in Kampong Cham region (Central Zone). But the soya-bean has been also cultivated in other regions such as Kep (in Kampot region) and in Takeo region (South-West Zone)

According to the experiences of the cooperative peasants, soya-bean gives a highest yield if cultivated on alluvial soil, clayey-sand soil or red soil.

Besides this soya-bean can be grown two times a year, except in inundated regions like along the rivers and some lowland regions. The first soya-bean is grown in April and collected in July or August, the second is grown in September and collected in December or January.

The experiences have shown that during the second stage of cultivation, in fresh season, soya-bean gives very excellent yield. In the cultivation, the cooperative peasants have paid attention to weed and touse insecticides.

As for the soya-bean crop, the cooperatives peasants use it to make salted soya, soya-sauce and other meals in order to contribute to further improve the people's standard of

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living. Besides this, the cooperative peasants use the soya-bean plants and leaves as excellent natural fertilizers for the soil improvement in rice-fields and other fields.

INTERNATIONAL NEWS

120803 - The Communist Party of Sri Lanka (Marxist-Leninist) condemns the Vietnam-Soviet Treaty.

"The Soviet Union has not only used Vietnam to aggress Kampuchea, but it aims at overthrowing other Governments in Southeast Asia." says the declaration of the Central Committee of the Communist Party of Sri Lanka (Marxist-Leninist) recently issued in order to denounce the true nature of the Vietnam-Soviet military Treaty. The declaration points out the danger of Soviet Union and its pawn, Vietnam to Southeast Asia and Asia and calls upon the peoples in this region to unite together and heighten their vigilance against the poisonous manoeuvres of the Soviet international expansionist big power and Vietnam.

120804 - Because of the criminal acts of the Le Duan-Pham Van Dong 's clique, the Vietnamese people continue to miserably die in the sea

Recently, many Vietnamese refugees boats successively sank: 5 boats near the Malaysian coast, 2 boats near the Thai coast, 1 boat near the Taiwan's coast, and caused several hundred deads.

The Le Duan-Pham Van Dong's clique does not only think of solving this painful situation, on the contrary it incitates and organizes the movement of fleeing abroad, in order, on the one hand, to have less people to feed and on the other hand, to infiltrate its agents to further carry out undermining activities serving its strategy of expansion and that of its masters, the Soviet international expansionists, in Southeast Asia and in Asia.

120805 - The Committee of Coordination of the Non-Aligned Countries condemns the racist regime of South Africa

Recently, the Committee of Coordination of the Non-Aligned Countries issued a statement condemning the racist regime of the white minority in South Africa which dispatched troops to aggress Namibia and for carrying out acts of sabotage and destructions against the movements of national liberation of the peoples in Southern Africa.
